- Discussion:

- x Jim Berry: The ACGM previously indicated only five criminal justice courses listed in the transferability list. This year while redoing the syllabi, four additional courses were added to the ACGM. CRIJ 2301 needs resources and corrections. In the past CRIJ 2301 has been listed as an approved elective and now it is placed as a transferable course. Request includes the removal of CJSA 1325 which is not in the ACGM list and make it the approved elective. CRIJ 2301 is a combination of a technical and academic course, and should be moved to the degree plan. No loss of course content since CJSA 1325 is the same course as Crime in America. Same textbooks can also be used.
